## Items to note:

**Page 1**: This page showcases the Key Performance Indicators on Housing First program contracts. It will show the final resulting percentage. This page details a numeric representation of where to find the numerator and denominator on subsequent pages.



The orange numbers found throughout this user guide mark the corresponding calculations as outlined on the next page

Page 2-5: Display the program's quarterly values.

# Intake/Entry/Move-in:

- Intake: Intake into program refers to an Entry on the Entry/exit tab of HMIS
- Move-in: The date the Move-in assessment is complete



<sup>3</sup> Calculated as the number of people with a move-in date over the quarter, plus the number of clients currently housed in the program at that quarter's 3 month assessment, divided by the target number.

<sup>4</sup> Calculated as % of all referrals canceled or declined for reason of: Client not eligible

<sup>5</sup> Calculated as the average # of days between when clients are referred to a program and intake into a program
